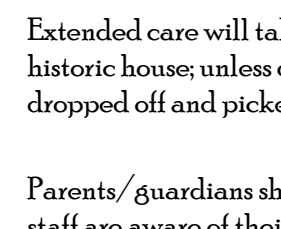

## Important Camp Information

### Arrival and Departure

Campers meet at Travellers Rest gift shop area Monday through Friday by 9 AM. Any camper dropped off before 8:50 AM will be charged for before care. Afternoon pick up will be at the same location from 3 PM until 3:15 PM. Campers left waiting for pick-up after this time will be sent to extended care and charged the daily rate. Any late morning arrivals should proceed to the education barn. Please be aware that with History's Mysteries camp we sometimes are late returning from the day's field trip due to traffic, etc.

Extended care will take place in the Discovery Room located in the 1885 wing of the historic house; unless otherwise noted. All extended care participants should be dropped off and picked up at this location.

Parents/guardians should sign in and sign out their camper and ensure that camp staff are aware of their child's arrival/departure.

### Lunch

Campers should bring a sack lunch and a bottle of water. A refrigerator and microwave are available for camp use.

Travellers Rest will provide an afternoon snack and drink. Every effort will be made to accommodate common food allergies such as peanuts. Parents may choose to send a snack to ensure their child's dietary needs are met.

On days with field trips and for History's Mysteries Camp everyone should bring a cold sack lunch and extra water.

### Stuff to bring and not bring!

You may want to send your own brand of sunscreen and/or insect repellent. Camp staff will have spf 50 sunblock and all-natural insect repellent on-hand.

Comfortable clothes and shoes that can get dirty and wet are recommended as water gun fights can be a common afternoon activity. Please note that Heely's are not allowed during camp hours or extended care.

Campers are allowed to have electronic devices such as mp3 players, handheld video games and cell phones during extended care. Please be aware that during camp hours all electronic devices will be collected and held by camp staff until the end of the day. No electronics will be permitted during Miss Mary's Academy.

### Miscellaneous

In most cases, specific details concerning field trips will be sent home with campers on the first day of their camp. History's Mysteries trips are kept secret until revealed by the scavenger hunt each day. Parents/Guardians who wish to know the itinerary should contact the Education Director for details. Permission slips are required before campers are allowed to participate in field trips.

### Refund & Cancellation Policy

The entire balance is due no later than May 31st. Failure to complete payment will result in the cancellation of your child's camp registration. Cancellations made prior to May 5th will receive a full refund. Cancellations made between May 5th-20th will receive a 50% refund. Any cancellations after May 20th will NOT be entitled to a refund. All cancellations are subject to a \$10 processing fee.

Extended care refunds will only be issued if cancellation is at least two weeks prior to the child's camp start date. Please note that extended care may be paid on a daily basis.

Travellers Rest reserves the right to cancel any week of camp that does not have at least 8 registered campers. In this case, Travellers Rest will issue a full refund.

### Directions

- From 65 South:** take Exit 78B – Harding Place West.
  - Go to the stoplight at Franklin Road and turn left onto Franklin.
  - After one-half mile, turn left on Lambert Drive next to large brick sign for John Overton High School.
  - At 3-way stop turn left onto Farrell Parkway.
  - Travellers Rest is on the left after going through the overpasses.

- From 65 North:** take Brentwood/Old Hickory Blvd. exit (west towards Brentwood)
  - Turn right onto Franklin Road at first major intersection.
  - After 3 miles, turn right onto Hogan Road.
  - Turn left onto Regent Drive after going through the overpass.
  - At the end of Regent, turn left onto Farrell Parkway and make an immediate right into TR.

- From 40 East or West:** Follow to 65 South (directions above)

- From 24 West:** Harding Place exit – west to Franklin Road (directions above)

\*\*\*There will be plenty of brown signs coming in from Franklin Road.
